When ready to submit samples, Production Part Approval Process (PPAP) is required. Failure Modes And Effects Analysis (FMEA) is a tool used for preventive actions. Measurement System Analysis (MSA) consist of calibration and Gauge Repeatability and Reproducibility (GR&R). Statistical Process Control (SPC) is used to control the processes.
